TRANSPORTATION PROJECT **- FORCE ACCOUNT -**

The Government of the United States of America, acting through its Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC), has entered into a \$ 175 million, five-year Compact with the Government of Nicaragua (GoN) to promote economic development in the departments of Chinandega and Leon. The Program funds three major projects: i) Road Rehabilitation, ii) Property Regularization and iii) Value-added rural business development with an emphasis on environmental sustainability. In accordance with the MCC Program Procurement Guidelines, MCA-Nicaragua notifies the direct contract with the firm "**Corporación de Empresas Regionales de la Construcción (COERCO)**" on January 23, 2008, for a total of 15 weeks and a total amount of U\$ 250,000.00 in concept of the emergency rehabilitation of the road Villanueva-Somotillo-Guasaule.
